## What is the IM Portal?

- One Web site for GoC employees to access IM resources
- Joint venture between Library and Archives Canada (LAC), Treasury Board Secretariat (TBS) and PWGSC





# **Objectives**

- To provide an objective, comprehensive and focused source of GoC, Canadian and international IM activities and resources
- To promote coordination of GoC IM activities, such as MGI implementation
- To build awareness and involvement in the GoC IM community



# Why Develop an IM Portal?

## THE CHALLENGE

- IM Information found on several sites: TBS (IMRC), LAC, community sites, etc.
- Overlaps, gaps, inconsistencies, conflicting points of view on IM topics





# Why Develop an IM Portal? (con't)

#### Mandated by IMPC in 2002 to:

- Ensure a government-wide approach to managing GoC information resources
- Eliminate duplication of effort & increase quality of existing information
- Save research time and promote increased access to IM resources
- Provide partnership opportunities for IM stakeholders

## Governance

## **Based on the GoC Cluster model:**

- Content management solution to harvest metadata about GoC resources
- Access to appropriate sources outside the GoC
- Resourced and hosted by departments, but functioning as a separate business unit.
