“Titles serve to distinguish individual works and also groups of works. I never thought that they provided any realistic clues to the experience of a work because there are no clues as such that could be provided. The significance of a work is the same thing as the experience of a work. I think that one reason persons seek for clues to a work is that they, perhaps unconsciously, identify the meaning of a work with its maker's intentions. This is just a confusion.”
