A lot of people...unlike doing commercial work, where there is a beginning... clearly a beginning, middle, and end to a story, a lot of my works purposefully start at the end and begin at the end - they go nowhere. I have just shared an experience with you...and I leave it open ended from where it came from and where it is going.
