So I don't make that great a distinction between the two. And all my life I've oscillated between very realistic things, on the one side and imaginative or imaginary constructions on the other side. And I just see them as poles of the practice that I'm involved in. Just as the way in the cinema you wouldn't think that a realistic film is any less filmic than a musical fantasy. They're both part of the cinema. And I see that this is the same in my work, they are different genres that I am interested in and I move between them.
