I don't see myself as a contemporary archeologist because unlike archeologists I'm not delving into past civilisations. I am delving into my own civilisation. So that's a common element in a number of pieces that I have done ... there is the territory and the product of that territory or there is the field and the archeological site within that field or rather a site that's equivalent to an archeological site.
