You may file an action in a state court or tribal court (if eligible) to obtain a child support order at any time.

- If you file a court action, you must serve notice on the Attorney General's office and the other party to your child support order.
- Filing a court action may not affect the child support owed under this notice for periods before a state or tribal court enters a child support order for your case.
