Check-in

At major stations, you will be greeted by our Service Manager (who is in charge of on-board services and personnel), and your ticket will be pre-checked prior to boarding the train.

Boarding

Silver & Blue class passengers enjoy priority boarding privileges. Your Service Attendant will meet you on the platform, show you to your quarters and explain the amenities offered on board.


Detailed information about the layout of the train and other on-board services and amenities is provided in a guest information directory located in your quarters.

Accommodations

Our sleeping cars offer a choice of comfortable private bedrooms or semi-private compartments supplied with thick towels, plump pillows, duvets and a handy route guide. By day, relax in comfortable armchairs and enjoy the view. At night, our staff will transform your personal area of the train into cozy sleeping quarters.

For your information, following is a general description of sleeping accommodations and amenities. Although the train is narrow and accommodations are compact, their ingenious design makes maximum use of limited space.









Single bedroom – A private one-person room with comfortable seat, picture window, call button, its own hand basin, power outlet, concealed toilet and vanity. At night, it becomes a snug sleeping area.

Double bedroom – By day, a private room for two, with armchairs, a large picture window, small closet, hand basin, power outlet, vanity, separate toilet, and foldout table on request. At night, it converts to upper and lower beds. Some bedrooms can be combined into a suite.

Upper and lower berths – Semi-private, with wide couch-style seats facing each other. At night, they convert to upper and lower beds with reading lights and heavy curtains for privacy. Shower and washrooms are a few steps away.

Showers – Shower facilities are available in each sleeping car (except the Park car). Attendants will provide a shower kit containing shampoo, soap and towels to each *Silver & Blue* class guest.

On-board power – 110V electric power outlets are available in enclosed accommodations.



Dining services

A superb menu awaits. All meals, prepared fresh each day by our chefs, are served in your assigned dining car. Depending on the length of your journey, breakfast, lunch and dinner are included in your fare. Vegetarian selections and children's menus are available. Check out our selection of excellent Canadian wines, which may be purchased to complement your meals. Guests may also purchase refreshments and snacks at our on-board take-out facilities. Visa, American Express, MasterCard, JCB, Discover and Diner's Club are accepted.

Special requests

Whenever possible, we will accommodate requests for special occasions or dietary requirements.
