- 2 Other OECD countries include: Australia, Iceland, New Zealand, Norway, Switzerland and Turkey.
- 3 If revenues are paid by residents of Canada, please allocate these amounts to the country or region of destination.
- 4 Charter payments are to be distributed geographically according to the country of residence of the party from whom the vessel was chartered.
- 5 Total expenses in item 7, are intended to include all out-payments made in **foreign** ports by Canadian operators on account of shipping business, e.g. crew wages and advances, harbour charges, canal dues, pilotage, towage, wharfage, stevedoring (inward and outward when paid by vessels), agency fees, fuel and supplies, repairs and on-payments to rail, truck, water and other carriers on through traffic. Distribute expenses to U.S., U.K. and other areas according to where the payments were made. Include estimates of open voyage accounts as at December 31 arising from voyages during the year.
