# Purpose of the Survey

To obtain information on the supply of and demand for energy in Canada, This information serves as an important indicator of Canadian economic performance, is used by all levels of government in establishing informed policies in the energy area and, in the case/of public utilities, is used by governmental agencies to fulfil their regulatory responsibilities. The private sector likewise uses this information in the corporate decision-making process.

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from publishing any statistics which would divalge information obtained from this survey that relates to any identifiable business. The data reported will be treated in strict confidence, used for statistical purposes and published in aggregate form only. The confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act are not affected by either the Access to Information Act or any other legislation. An exception to the general rule of confidentiality under the Statistics Act is the disclosure, at the discretion of the Chief Statistician, of identifiable information relating to public utilities, which, includes undertakings supplying petroleum or petroleum products by pipeline, and undertakings supplying, transmitting or distributing gas, electricity or steam. This applies to the dissemination of aggregate survey results at the provincial or territorial level where only one or two public utilities may have reported data or where one dominates the industry in a particular province or territory.

### **Data Sharing Agreements**

To reduce response burden and to ensure uniform statistics, Statistics Canada has entered into data sharing agreements with various agencies and government departments for the joint collection and sharing of data from this survey. The information provided in this survey pertaining to individual respondents can not be disclosed, in any way, by the parties with which Statistics Canada has agreements.

Agreements exist under section 11 of the Statistics Act to share information with the statistical agencies of Nova Scotia, Saskatchewan and Alberta regarding business establishments located or operating in their respective province. These provincial statistical agencies have been established under provincial legislation authorizing them to collect this information on their own or jointly with Statistics Canada. The provincial legislation in those three provinces also contains the same confidentiality protection and outlines similar penalties for disclosure of confidential information as the federal Statistics Act.

Agreements exist under Section 12 of the Statistics Act with the Ontario Ministry of Energy, Manitoba Industry, Trade and Mines, Saskatchewan Industry and Resources, the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board, and the British Columbia Ministry of Energy and Mines to share the information collected by this survey for the respective provincial jurisdiction. Under Section 12 of the Statistics Act you may refuse to share your information by writing the Chief Statistician and returning your letter of objection along with the completed questionnaire in the enclosed return envelope. Note that there is no right to refusal with respect to sharing the data with the Albertal Energy and Utilities Board and Saskatchewan Industry and Resources. The rinformation is collected in Alberta under the Statistics Act and on behalf of the Board under the authority ∞i the ⊘oal Conservation Act and Regulations or the Oil and Gas Conservation Act and Regulations. In Saskatchewan, the information is collected under the Statistics Act and on behalf of the Department pursuant to the Saskatchewan Oil and Gas Conservation Act and Regulations, 1985 and the Saskatchewan Mineral Resources Act.

Do not enter data in shaded areas.

This questionnairé is to be completed by companies confined to one province.
