Survey Objective The survey objective is the collection and publication of data necessary for the statistical analysis of the consumer goods cental industry. The information from the survey can be used by businesses and trade associations for market analysis and assessment of industry performance, operating characteristics and trends, by government to develop national and regional economic policies, by other users involved in research or policy making and by Statistics Canada for maintaining important data input to the preparation of the Canadian System of National Accounts.

Confidentiality

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from publishing any statistics which would divulge information relating to any identifiable business without the previous written consent of that business. The data reported on this questionnaire will be treated in strict confidence, used for statistical purposes, and published in aggregate form only. The confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act are not affected by either the Access to Information Act or by any other legislation.

Data Sharing Agreements In order to reduce response burden and to provide consistent statistics, Statistics Canada has entered into data sharing agreement with the statistical agency of *Quebec* in accordance with Section 11 of the Statistics Act, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, Chapter S19. For business locations operated in *Quebec*, the agreement authorizes Statistics Canada to forward a record of the data collected in this survey to the statistical agency of this province. The Statistics Acts of this province includes the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for disclosure of information as the federal Statistics Act.
