### Information for Respondents

#### Survey Objective

This survey collects financial and operating data for the statistical measurement and analysis of the telecommunications industry (telecom carriage or resale). These data will be aggregated to produce estimates of national and provincial economic production in Canada as well as estimates of activity by industry. These estimates are used by government for national and regional programs and policy planning, by the private sector for industry performance measurement and market development and by the aforementioned parties, international telecommunications organizations, academics, analysts, and the general public to better understand this sector's role in the social and economic fabric of Canada. Selected results of this survey will be published in Statistics Canada Catalogue No. 56-203-XIE.

#### Authority

This survey is collected under the authority of the Statistics Act, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, Chapter S19. Completion of this questionnaire is a legal requirement under this Act.

#### Confidentiality

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from publishing or releasing any statistics which would divulge information obtained from this survey relating to any identifiable business without the previous written consent of that business. **The data on this questionnaire will be treated in confidence, used for statistical purposes and published in aggregate form only.** The confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act are not affected by the Access to Information Act or any other legislation. **Please note that Statistics Canada does not share any individual responses with Canada Customs and Revenue Agency (formerly Revenue Canada).**

#### Data Sharing Agreement

To reduce response burden and to ensure more uniform statistics, Statistics Canada has entered into a data sharing agreement under section 11 of the Statistics Act with the Institut de la statistique du Québec, to share information from this survey concerning respondents' Quebec operations. The Quebec Statistics Act gives the Institut de la statistique du Québec the authority to collect the information requested in this report on their own and it contains the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for disclosure of information as the federal Statistics Act.

#### Reporting Period

This questionnaire should be completed for the fiscal year ending on a date between April 1, 2000 and March 31, 2001.
