#### Information for Respondents

#### **Survey Objective**

This survey collects financial and operating data for the statistical measurement and analysis of the telecommunications industry (telecom carriage or resale). The confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act are not affected by the Access to Information Act or any other legislation.
