The data are used by Statistics Canada as input to the System of National Accounts. The information is also used by the Bank of Canada, Finance Canada, Industry Canada, provincial agencies, trade associations, universities and international organizations for macroeconomic policy development and/or analysis and as a measure of regional activity.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

The agreements we have with these agencies require that they keep the information confidential and use it only for statistical and research purposes. Under section 12, respondents may object to the sharing of their information with any of these agencies by giving notice in writing to the Chief Statistician and by returning their letter of objection along with the completed questionnaire in the enclosed objection along with the completed questionnaire in the enclosed envelope
