

Information for Respondents

- Authority:** Statistics Act, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, Chapter S19.
- Objective:** This survey collects essential data to produce statistics on the incidence and characteristics of homicide offences in Canada. In aggregate form, it is used by federal and provincial policy makers as well as public and private researchers. The data are also widely disseminated by the media for purposes of general public information.
- Confidentiality:** Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from publishing any statistics which would divulge information obtained from this survey that relates to any identifiable respondent/individual without the previous written consent of that respondent/individual.
