

Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics (SLID), 2003 reference year: January 2004 preliminary interview questionnaire

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Executive Summary

A Preliminary interview of background information is collected for all respondents aged 16 and over, who enter the sample for the Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics (SLID). For the majority of the longitudinal respondents, this occurs when a new panel is introduced and the preliminary information is collected during the first Labour interview. However, all persons living with a longitudinal respondent are also interviewed for SLID. Thus Preliminary interviews are conducted for new household members during their first Labour interview after they join the household. Longitudinal persons with have turned 16 while their household is in the SLID sample are then eligible for SLID interviews so they are asked the Preliminary interview questions curing their first Labour interview.

The purpose of this document is to present the questions, possible responses and question flows for the 2004 Preliminary questionnaire (for the 2003 reference year).

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1. Introduction

A Preliminary interview of background information is collected for all respondents aged 16 and over who enter the Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics (SLID) sample. For the majority of the longitudinal respondents, this occurs when a new panel is introduced and the preliminary information is collected during the first Labour interview. However, all persons living with a longitudinal respondent are also interviewed for SLID. Preliminary interviews are conducted for new household members (joiners) during their first Labour interview after they join the household. Longitudinal persons who have turned 16 while their household is in the SLID sample are then eligible for SLID interviews so they are asked the Preliminary interview questions during their first Labour interview.

A labour questionnaire is collected for all respondents 16 years of age and over. Panel 4, introduced in 2003 for reference year 2002 and now consisting of approximately 17,000 households, completed its second year with the survey. Panel 3, introduced in 2000 for reference year 1999 and now consisting of approximately 17,000 households, completed its fifth year.

This research paper presents the content of the 2004 Preliminary interview (for the 2003 reference year) including question wording, possible responses and flows of questions.

2. Content

The Preliminary interview has three main modules:

- EX: Work Experience data on both part- and full-time work;
- DE: Family and Personal History marital history, birth history, mother tongue, place of birth, ethnic origin;
- EP: Educational Attainment certificates and degrees, years of schooling, and parents' level of education.

3. What's new

Modified questions:

EX_Q020

A wording change was made, in French only, to response category 1.

EX Q050

The word "complètes" was added in French only.

DE_Q035

A wording change was made to the question in French only.

A "Yes" response to this question now flows to DE_Q055 (instead of DE_Q045).

DE Q050

A question text change was made in French only (to be consistent with English)

DE Q095

Given possible changes that may arise in language learning between French and English (and vice versa) and the ir creasingly multicultural nature of our society, an interviewer note has been a fact to this question (which is consistent with the 2001 Census question) that reads as follows: If the person no longer understands the first language learned andicate the second language learned.

DE Q105

This question has been reworded to be consistent with the 2001 Census question. Also, an increwer note has been added to explain the concept of a "landed immigrant".

DE Q110

Given that the wording of question DE_Q105 has been changed, question DE_Q110 has been changed as well to be consistent with the 2001 Census question. The Census interviewer note has also been added to this question.

DE Q125

"Treaty Indian" has been added to the question in English only. It was already included in the French question (and is consistent with the Census question).

DE Q130

The wording of the question has been changed in both English and French. The order of the response categories has been changed (some categories have been deleted and new ones have been added); there are now 25 specific categories to choose from. "Other (specify)" has been moved to category 26. The categories produced in SLID now match the 25 examples given in the Census. Consistency with the Census should take precedence over such factors as comparability between years and purely analytical considerations. In fact, it was clearly established as of June 24, 2003 that SLID was directly dependent on the subject-matter expertise of the Census for demographic variables.

The text for response category 3 was changed in French only.

EP Q075

The text for response category 2 vas changed in French only.

EP N075

Small text changes were rade to response categories 02, 03, 05 and 06 in French only.

The text for response category 03 was changed in French only.

EP Q095 and EP_Q100

Small text changes were made to response categories 01 and 06 in French only.

4. How to read this document

This document is a written approximation of the CAI interview, or the "questionnaire". The CAI process is as follows:

- (a) A question appearing on the computer screen is read aloud to the respondent.
- (b) The respondent's answer is directly entered into the computer by the interviewer.
- (c) Based on the answer given, and/or age or other flow criteria, the computer determines the next question to be asked and displays it on the screen.

Question numbers: For each section, the question numbers refer to the actual numbers used in the collection application which appear on in interviewer's computer screen. Bold text is read, as worded, by the interviewer. Instructions for the interviewer are preceded by the word, "INTERVIEWER" and are not read out loud to the respondent.

Naming conventions: Naming conventions were changed to conform to the standards for Statistics Canada social surveys

Pre-fill items: So own in square brackets [] are items specific to each respondent's uncryiew. The application includes the relevant information into the question, making it simply a matter of reading for the interviewer. Pre-fill items include:

[respondent] – This is the first and last name of the household member to whom the questions refer. This is not necessarily the person who is talking to the interviewer.

[current year] – This is the year **during which** the information is collected. [reference year] – This is the year **for which** the information is collected. [age] – This is the respondent's age in years, calculated as of January 1 of the current year.

[years ago] – This is the number of years ago the respondent first started working.

Headers: For some questions, important information is noted at the top of the screen. In this document, this information is given at the beginning of each section description.

Ranges: Hard ranges are specified for some of the questions. The hard range gives the highest and lowest acceptable response values. The system will not accept a number outside the range. A soft range specifies an upper and lower limit which if exceeded will result in a probe to confirm that the amount entered is correct. The entry is allowed as long as it is not outside the hard range.

Dates: All dates are in DD/MM/YYYY format unices otherwise specified.
