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Self-Sufficiency Project

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Introduction

This manual contains the survey instruments that were used for the 72 month follow-up of the Self-Sufficiency Project. This was the last of four follow-up surveys of Income Assistance applicants. Interviewers used computer assisted interviewing to update information relating to marital history, employment, education, job search activity, child care, personal attitudes, etc. In addition, parents were asked to complete a paper self-complete questionnaire.

Objectives

The Self-Sufficiency Project is a Federal Pilot program conducted in New Brunswick and British Columbia. It offers an earnings supplement to single parents who had previously been on income assistance.

The goals of the Self-Sufficiency Project are:

- € To provide financial incentives that increase the rate at which income assistance recipients take jobs and the hours they work in these jobs.
- € To increase, through jobs, the rate at which recipients leave income assistance.
- € To reduce the rate at which recipients who get jobs return to income assistance.
- € To increase the income and overall well-being of income assistance recipients who work.
- € To develop a program that is cost effective - that is, government savings in income assistance costs exceed the costs of the wage subsidies.

Computer Assisted Interviews

Data were collected using Computer-Assisted Interviewing techniques. The CAI application is programmed to ensure that only valid question responses can be entered and that all the correct flows are followed. Edits can be built into the application to check consistency of responses, identify and correct outliers, and control who gets asked specific questions. This means that the data are already quite “clean” at the end of the collection process, and allows us to deliver a final data file more quickly.

Contents of this Manual

This manual contains the actual survey instruments used in the Self-Sufficiency Project 72 month Applicant Follow-up Survey as well as a brief introduction to each instrument. The majority of the 72 month survey was taken from the 48 month survey. The only exceptions were the “attitude” module in the core questionnaire and the paper parent self-complete questionnaire, which were taken from the 36 month recipient survey. The child care module in the core application was developed specifically for the 72 month survey.

Survey Procedures

Procedures for interviewers were as follows:

- € An introductory letter was sent out by the Regional Office to explain the purpose of the survey.
- € The interviewer contacted the respondent by telephone to verify or update the address, household composition and demographics for the household (Section A).
- € The interviewer made an appointment with the respondent for a personal interview or, if the respondent chose, conducted the core questionnaire over the telephone and mailed the parent self-complete questionnaire to the respondent for completion. A self-addressed stamped envelope was included for the respondent to mail back the questionnaire.
- € The interviewer went to the respondent’s home to administer the computer-assisted core questionnaire (Sections B to J) and the parent self-complete questionnaire.
- € Once the core questionnaire was completed, the case was ready for transmission to Head Office. The parent self-complete questionnaires were data captured in the regional office and then sent to Head Office for archiving.

Introductory Letter to Respondents

An Introductory letter to the respondent was sent out from the regional office several weeks before interviewing was set to begin. The letter describes the purpose of the survey, the status of the project, and the importance of the respondent's involvement in the project.

A sample of this letter appears on the next page. The letters were sent with the letterhead of the Pacific Regional Office.

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June, 2001

Thank you for taking part in the Self-Sufficiency Project. Seven years ago, the Ministry of Social Services encouraged you to assist us in this study which looks at ways to help people support themselves by working. Like you, almost everyone that started this study is still participating.

The Self-Sufficiency Project is beginning a new phase. Soon, a Statistics Canada interviewer will contact you about our 72-month interview. We will update the information on your family, work, education and child care needs. We will also ask you to allow your children to participate. The information about your children will help determine if the Self-Sufficiency Project has influenced their well-being and development.

This research will benefit Canadian children in the future so we hope you will agree. It is your decision whether or not to allow your children to participate in the project. As we did when the project started, we will ask you to sign an "Informed Consent Form" which will allow our interviewer to give your children a short test and ask them to complete a questionnaire. Our interviewer will explain the test in more detail at the time of the interview.

Statistics Canada ensures that the information we collect about your children is confidential. Only the people doing research for this project will use this information.

We look forward to your continuing involvement in the Self-Sufficiency Project which is sponsored by Human Resources Development Canada and managed by a non-profit organization, the Social Research Demonstration Corporation. 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Section A

Entry Module (Demographics)

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DEMOGRAPHICS SECTION

The interviewer contacts the respondent by telephone and, following the questions which appear in this module, updates the demographic information for the household. Detailed information about the relationship of family members to one another is collected for the first time in the 72 month follow-up survey.

Once this section has been completed, the interviewer makes an appointment with the respondent for a personal interview.

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Introduction

This paper provides the basic specifications and documentation for the Entry and Exit questions that are used at the beginning of the SSP 72 month survey. These questions are grouped into “blocks”, and each block is programmed individually.

The following conventions are used in these specifications:

1. Question text in Bold font is read to the respondent. Text in normal font is not read to the respondent. Interviewer instructions are prefaced by the word “INTERVIEWER”, and are not read aloud.
2. The options Don’t Know (DK) and Refusal (R) are allowed on every question unless otherwise stated. However, the response categories are shown in this document only when the flow from these responses is not to the next question.
3. Square brackets are used to identify text fills that are replaced with actual data during an interview.
