- Plant crops
- Fertilize cultivate, and irrigate land
- Harvest crops
- Sort, weigh and pack fruit and vegetables at farm
- Load, unload and transfer crates, supplies and farm produce
- Clean up racks, trays, growing and packaging areas
- Examine produce for quality and prepare for market

Nursery and Greenhouse Labourer

- Prepare soil
- Plant bulbs, seeds and cuttings
- Graft and bud plants
- Transplant seedlings and rooted cuttings
- Position and regulate greenhouse and outdoor irrigation systems to water plants and fields
- Dig, cut and transplant trees, shrubs, flowers and plants and prepare them for sale
