## IMPORTATION OF TIRES

The information contained in this Interim Memorandum will be incorporated into Memorandum D19-12-2, *Importation of Tires*, dated December 31, 1997. It does not supersede it.

Effective immediately, Transport Canada is waiving the customs release requirements for the importation of tires provided in D19-12-2 for importers approved on the Customs Self Assessment (CSA) program.
