NOVA SCOTIA CA's

Mixed Results in Province's Apartment Rental Market

The average vacancy rate for rental units declined over the past year in two out of the four largest urban areas of Nova Scotia outside of Halifax. Vacancy rates ranged from a low of 2.7 per cent in Kentville, to a high of 7.4 per cent in Cape Breton. The average rent for two bedroom apartment units increased in only one of the four centres. The average rent for a two bedroom apartment ranged from a low of \$493 in New Glasgow, to a high of \$573 in Truro.

The apartment vacancy rate in the Cape Breton Regional Municipality continued its downward trend falling to 7.4 per cent this October from 11.1 per cent last year. Cape Breton was the only urban area in Nova Scotia outside of Halifax to see rising rental rates. The average rent for a two bedroom apartment increased 2.3 per cent from \$517 to \$529 per month over the past year.

The New Glasgow rental market vacancy rate declined by 2.1 per cent reversing last year's rise in vacancy rates. The apartment rental vacancy rate fell from 5.9 per cent in 2001 to 3.8 per cent this year. Even though rental demand strengthened in New Glasgow this year, rental rates declined. The average monthly rent for a two bedroom apartment fell \$12 or 2.4 per cent from \$505 last year to \$493 this October.


The Kentville apartment rental market also reversed a trend of declining vacancy rates this year. Kentville reported a modest 0.2 per cent increase in its vacancy rate, climbing from 2.5 per cent to 2.7 per cent over the past twelve months. This slight easing in rental market conditions is a likely contributing factor to keeping the average two bedroom rent in Kentville unchanged at \$534.


The rental market in Truro also eased this year with the vacancy rate rising from 2.9 per cent to 3.6 per cent. With more vacant units available to rent, landlords were generally unable to raise rents this year. The average rent for a two bedroom apartment in Truro remained relatively unchanged this year declining only \$1 from \$574 to \$573.
