## Vacancy Rate Edges Higher in 2002

The Barrie CA vacancy rate increased for the second consecutive year. The results of the October 2002 Rental Market Survey indicate that the vacancy rate for private apartments in the Barrie CA is 1.4 per cent. Low mortgage rates are prompting some tenants to move to the ownership market resulting in softer rental demand.

Vacancy rates increased in all bedroom types with the exception of three plus bedroom apartments. Both bachelor and one bedroom apartments experienced a marginal increase in vacancies to 0.8 per cent and 0.9 per cent respectively. The highest vacancy rate is for two bedroom apartments at 1.8 per cent. The two bedroom vacancy rate has doubled since 2001. Three plus bedroom apartment vacancies edged down to 0.9 per cent in October.

The average rent for all apartment types dipped by 0.6 per cent this year reflecting softer demand. The Barrie CA had seen two bedroom rents climb by 6.1 per cent in 2001. This year, the average two bedroom rent dipped back by 0.5 per cent and the vacancy rate doubled suggesting that rent increases next year will be modest. In 2002, the average rent for bachelor apartments increased marginally to \$605, while rents for three plus bedroom apartments jumped by 7.8 per cent. Demand for three plus bedroom units improved this year, however, they represent only 6 per cent of the total apartment universe.

The vacancy rate increased to 2 per cent in Collingwood and 3.1 per cent in Midland. Orillia experienced a decline in the vacancy rate to 1.5 per cent in October of 2002.
