Sault Vacancy Rate remains high, but stable

The vacancy rate for Sault Ste. Marie rose slightly in October to 11.1 per cent from 10.9 per cent in 2001. The survey marks the fifth consecutive year that CMHC has recorded a vacancy rate over ten per cent.

Two bedroom vacancies remain high, but stable, with 12.1 per cent of two bedroom units being vacant, down from 12.2 percent in 2001. The one bedroom rate remains relatively low with the rate being 8.9 per cent, down from 9.2 per cent in October 2001. Small sample sizes lead to volatility in three bedroom and bachelor unit analysis. For instance, a large jump in three bedroom unit vacancies saw the vacancy rate for three bedroom apartments in the Sault climb to 15.3 per cent from 8.8 per cent last year.

Rent data reveals little pressure to increase rents in a high vacancy environment. Two bedroom rents fell by one dollar from 2001 to \$612 in October 2002.

Zone 2 or the East End of the city continues to have the lowest vacancy situation with 4.9 per cent of units being vacant as of the October survey, down from 5.6 per cent last October. Both the Downtown, or Zone I, and Zone 3, the West end, saw their vacancy rates rise to 15.0 and 15.8 per cent respectively.

CMHC surveyed 4.858 apartment units during its October survey, down from 4.912 last year. Fifty-six per cent of the units were two bedrooms, while 34 per cent were one bedroom units. CMHC's survey is done each October and covers all centres in Canada with at least 10,000 people.
