Export Information

Information such as market studies, sector profiles, legal issues, foreign market statistics and much more is available in the C/MBSC library.

Skills Development

Workshops cover a range of topics such as the *Going Global* series on basic export skills and the Forum for International Trade Training skills program, which can lead to a professional designation. Additional market development sessions include: marketing internationally, researching foreign markets, trade financing, trade logistics and various niche topics.

Export Counselling

Assistance provided in Export Readiness Assessment, Export Plan Development and Export Plan Implementation.

Market Entry Support

Market Entry Support Services are designed to assist companies that have researched and selected their target markets. Market entry support services include: market/sector intelligence, trade missions, market sector advice and market development funding.

Export Financing

Export Financing Services include: helping you develop market opportunities, securing working capital, financing foreign receivables, arranging for pre-delivery financing and insuring your receivables.

In-Market Assistance

Once you have researched and selected your target markets, assistance is available to help you: answer market access questions, find foreign business contacts and leads, and provide advice on technology transfer and investment attraction.

Investment Retention and Attraction

Assistance related to attracting and retaining foreign direct investment to Manitoba.

VIRTUAL TRADE COMMISSIONER

(formerly WIN Exports)

The Virtual Trade Commissioner is your personal gateway to the Canadian Trade Commissioner Service. The VTC is a new on-line database that has replaced WIN Exports.

Each user receives a personalized Web page containing market information and business leads that match the user's international business interests. Some of the services available and/or provided by the VTC include:

- Direct contact information for the Trade Commissioner responsible for your sector in your market(s) of interest
- The ability to request Trade Commissioner services online
- Notification of new market research and events as they become available
- Notification of any market prospects and/or opportunities in your sector in your market(s) of interest
- Your VTC profile makes information on your company available to the 500 Trade Commissioners in 140 Canadian offices abroad

To receive your customized Virtual Trade Commissioner, all you have to do is register as a client of the Trade Commissioner Service by completing the registration form available at www.infoexport.gc.ca. Login to your Virtual Trade Commissioner anytime to view market information, business opportunities, make service requests and even update your company's registration information. Best of all, it's FREE!

PROGRAM FOR EXPORT MARKET DEVELOPMENT (PEMD)

The PEMD program is designed to assist exportready companies enter new markets by sharing the cost of activities that businesses normally could not, or would not, undertake alone. These include attending trade fairs in a specific market, developing and implementing an international marketing plan of activities or bidding on major capital projects abroad.

TRADE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Trade Assistance Program assists small and medium-sized Manitoba firms to launch products in new markets outside the province by costsharing participation in a recognized trade show. The program is open to Manitoba firms with fewer than 125 employees, that either operate manufacturing facilities in the province, or offer exportable services. The program is available primarily for trade shows outside of Canada. Participation in trade shows in Canada is restricted to new exporters who have no previous experience exporting.

EXPORT ORIENTATION PROGRAMS

These are a series of programs to help you learn about international markets and how to gain access to them. These include:

NEBS

The New Exporters to Border States program is a key export education tool for companies just starting out in exporting to the United States. It includes a visit to one of the Canadian Consulates and meeting with trade officers.

EXTUS

The Exporters to the United States program is directed at companies already exporting to the U.S. who want to expand their export business. It includes trade mini-missions that last from one to three days and are often coordinated with trade shows in the U.S. to give participants a closer look at a specific sector. It provides sessions with industry experts and helps the exporter to establish networks with distributors, representatives and buyers.

NEXOS

New Exporters to Overseas is a program to introduce companies to European markets.

PEMD INVESTMENT
