Re-evaluation Decision Document

Fosamine Ammonium

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of fosamine ammonium is now complete.

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that fosamine ammonium is acceptable for continued registration provided that the proposed mitigation measures are adopted and the data requirements are addressed.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of fosamine ammonium as published in the Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document, <u>PACR2004-05</u>, on 16 April 2004.

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1.0 Introduction

The re-evaluation of the available information for the active ingredient fosamine ammonium and its associated uses as a herbicide on non-cropland to control brush and herbaceous plants has been completed by the PMRA.

2.0 Background

The purpose of this RRD is to notify the registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of fosamine ammonium is now complete.

On 16 April 2004, the PMRA published <u>PACR2004-05</u>, *Re-evaluation of Fosamine Ammonium*, for consultation on the proposed regulatory decision for fosamine ammonium. No comments were received by the PMRA concerning this PACR.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of fosamine ammonium.

3.0 Regulatory decision

The PMRA has determined that fosamine ammonium is acceptable for continuing registration provided that the mitigation measures specified in the PACR are implemented.

Section 5.0 of the PACR outlined additional data requirements for continued registration of fosamine ammonium. The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
