



Re-evaluation Decision Document

RRD2004-19

Sulphur

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of sulphur is now complete.

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that sulphur is acceptable for continued registration provided that the proposed mitigation measures are adopted and the data requirements are addressed.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of sulphur as published in the Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document, [PACR2004-10](#), on 7 May 2004.

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1.0 Introduction

The re-evaluation of the available information for the active ingredient sulphur and its associated uses as a fungicide, insecticide and acaricide for commercial and domestic crops, and as a rodenticide in a domestic setting is now complete.

2.0 Background

The purpose of this RRD is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of sulphur is now complete.

On 7 May 2004, the PMRA published [PACR2004-10](#), *Re-evaluation of Sulphur*, for consultation on the proposed regulatory decision for sulphur. No comments were received by the PMRA concerning this PACR.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of sulphur.

3.0 Regulatory decision

The PMRA has determined that sulphur is acceptable for continuing registration provided that the mitigation measures specified in the PACR are implemented.

Section 5.0 of the PACR outlined additional data requirements for continued registration of sulphur. The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
