



Re-evaluation Decision Document

Daminozide

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of daminozide is now complete.

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that daminozide is acceptable for continued registration provided that the proposed mitigation measures are adopted and the data requirements are addressed.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of daminozide as published in the Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document, [PACR2004-24](#), on 6 July 2004.

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1.0 Introduction

The re-evaluation of the available information for the active ingredient daminozide and its associated non-food uses in the nursery/greenhouse industry as a plant growth regulator has been completed by the PMRA.

2.0 Background

The purpose of this RRD is to notify the registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of daminozide is now complete.

On 6 July 2004, the PMRA published PACR2004-24, *Re-evaluation of Daminozide*, for consultation on the proposed regulatory decision for daminozide. No comments were received by the PMRA concerning this PACR.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of daminozide.

3.0 Regulatory decision

The PMRA has determined that daminozide is acceptable for continuing registration provided that the mitigation measures specified in the PACR are implemented.

Section 5.0 of the PACR outlined additional requirements for continued registration of daminozide. The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
