## Re-opening Consultation for Phosalone

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Note is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public of the re-opening of the consultation period for the proposed re-evaluation decision on phosalone.

On 13 June 2005, Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration document <u>PACR2005-02</u>, *Re-evaluation of Phosalone*, was published for a 60-day consultation period. It provides a summary of the data and information reviewed as well as the rationale for the proposed regulatory decision for phosalone.

The new *Pest Control Products Act* was brought into force on 28 June 2006 and requires that the consultation period for phosalone be re-opened.

By way of this Re-evaluation Note, Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) is soliciting additional comments from interested parties on the proposed regulatory decision for phosalone as outlined in PACR2005-02. Resubmission of comments sent during the initial consultation period is not required. The PMRA will accept written comments on this proposal up to 45 days from the date of publication of this Re-evaluation Note.
