CUSTOMS NOTICE N-515

Plastic Shrinkable Bags, Originating in or Exported From the United States of America

- 1. The purpose of this customs notice is to advise that the review of the undertaking initiated on January 17, 2003, with respect to plastic shrinkable bags, whether in finished or semi-finished (tubular) form, for vacuum packaging of meat and other food products, originating in or exported from the United States of America has been concluded.
- 2. The Commissioner of Customs and Revenue, having reviewed the undertakings originally accepted from exporters in the United States of America and their related importers on April 5, 1994, and renewed on April 4, 1997, and April 3, 2000, for three-year periods, decided not to renew the undertakings with respect to the above-mentioned goods.

- 3. Therefore, the undertakings in question expired on April 2, 2003, in accordance with subsection 53(2) of the *Special Import Measures Act*, as it read prior to the January 1, 1995, legislative amendments. The expiration terminates all proceedings under the Act.
