CUSTOMS NOTICE N-533

Revised Memorandum D9-1-1

- 1. This notice informs the public of a change regarding the importation of obscene materials.
- 2. Effective September 9, 2003, Memorandum D9-1-1, Jurisprudence and Revenue Canada's Interpretative Policy for the Administration of Tariff Item No. 9899.00.00 On Goods Deemed to be Obscene Under Subsection 163(8) of Criminal Code, dated October 4, 1999, will be revoked. It will be replaced by D9-1-1, Canada Customs and Revenue Agency's Policy on the Classification of Obscene Material, dated September 9, 2003.
- 3. Please note that the indicators of obscenity have been amended and that definitions of these indicators have now been provided for greater clarity. Further, the forms K27, *Notice of Detention/Determination*, and K27A, *Continuation*

Sheet, have also been amended accordingly and will be available internally on the InfoZone effective September 9, 2003. Please destroy all unused copies of any previous versions of these forms, dated 2001, 1998 or earlier.
