CUSTOMS NOTICE 642

Surtax Imposed on Certain Products From the United States

- 1. The purpose of this notice is to inform importers that the surtax imposed on certain products from the United States ended on April 30, 2006 (midnight). This surtax was brought into effect by Order-in-Council SOR/2005-106 (P.C. 2005-615), Order Suspending the Application of Concessions on Imports of Certain Products Originating in the United States, dated April 19, 2005.
- 2. As outlined in Customs Notice N-613, this surtax applied to imports of live swine, live ornamental fish, oysters, certain frozen fish and cigarettes originating in the United States. The tariff item numbers for these goods are as follows:

3. Any of the above goods originating in the United States, with a date of release prior to May 1, 2006, will be subject to the surtax.

4. Corrections to original declarations, requests for refunds and requests for re-determinations or re-appraisals can be made in the prescribed form and manner under the relevant provisions of the *Customs Act* and in accordance with the procedures outlined in the following memoranda:
