3. Advance payment

- 17. Record the amount the applicant is requesting in Box D. Ensure that this amount does not exceed the lesser of Boxes A, B or C.
- 18. Determine the amount you can issue as a first payment. That amount cannot exceed 60 per cent of Box D.


