Background

- A study Commissioned by Treasury Board to study IM Capacity of Small Agencies (December 2004)

Results:

- IM capacity is consistent across the small agency community (TBS Report, March 2005)
- Efforts should now be concentrated on building capacity
- Seven distinct areas were identified, which become basis for Small Agency Strategy
- LAC volunteers to lead SAS initiative on behalf of the SAAN
