






Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada

- APF "Next Generation" Planning underway









Information Management – Suite of Tools

- AgriDOC (RDIMS, Hummingbird)
- Content Management Solution (Interwoven Teamsite)
 - Provide enterprise approach to manage content for both internet and intranet
- Enterprise Search (Autonomy's Verity K2)
 - Web Search in production
- Metadata (Metatagger)
 - Metadata as the underpinning for IM tools, integration, information management and compliance, information architecture (dynamic web delivery), enhanced search
- Unified Portal Software Solution (Oracle suite)
 - Portal and Collaboration tools, security and application architecture
- Forms Project (Adobe)








Integrated IM Solution – IM Lifecycle Perspective

AgriDOC

Business needs addressed:

- Align all document-based information with the APF and Outcome Projects
- Provide AAFC Teams with a standard mechanism to share and control documents across the country
- Provide a standard foundation upon which to build document-based Information Management systems
- Ensure Departmental compliance with Federal Regulations for the preservation of Official Records





AgriDOC Current Status

- Current licenses/solutions deployed
 - Approximately 2000 licenses deployed to date
 - 1600 additional new licenses to be deployed during 2007/2008
 - Business solutions developed using AgriDOC
 - Executive Correspondence Management Solution (ECMS)
 - Forward Agenda Planning and Report Solution (FAPRS)
 - System for Tracking Agri-Food Technologies Solution (STAT)
 - Procurement and Planning Solution (PPS)
 - Ministerial Invitation Tracking and reporting Solution (MITS)
 - Farm Income Policy Division Faxination
 - 500,000+ documents/objects in AgriDOC repository
 - Project undergoing migration from RDIMS 4.7 to Hummingbird Enterprise 2005 (DM/RM 6)







Content Management Solution

Adoption of a Web Content Management Solution to address:

- Business Needs
 - Improved management of the Web publishing process
 - More agility to update content and sites
- Communication Needs
 - Improved brand consistency
 - Governance through use of workflows
- Information Management Needs
 - Tools to support GoC Acts and Policies (Accountability Act, Management of Government Information, Communications Policy, etc.)







CMS - Current Status and Approach

- Release 1.0 Baseline CMS Solution
 - Initial solution targeted at existing Web publishing team (i.e. business owners not yet using system)
 - 4 Data Capture Templates (Generic, News Releases, Speeches, Backgrounders)
 - 4 Workflows (Emergency, Publish, Delete, Metadata, Preview)
 - New dynamic front-end to support content reuse







CMS – Plans for future releases

- Extending solution to priority end-users such as the Media Room
 - Additional templates and workflows
- Improvements to support the information architecture needs of AAFC's Web Renovation project
- Enhancements to classification process
 - Integration of MetaTagger for auto-classification
 - Bulk-edit functionality
 - Auto-synchronization between languages
- Enhanced approach to managing digital assets associated with web pages i.e. images and PDFs
- Supporting Web content delivery needs of AAFC's My Account
- Integration with other IM tools such as RDIMS, Portal





Unified Portal Software Solution

Vision

 Provide a single window access to integrated and accurate APF programs and AAFC Services for enhanced online service delivery, decision making and performance management

Mandate

- Increase productivity through efficient access to relevant content, tools and applications;
- Improve information sharing and collaboration with customers, partners, and suppliers;
- Streamline business processes and reduce enterprise costs by connecting applications that eliminate paper-based and other manual procedures;
- Decrease IT Costs via common secure infrastructure and reusable components.





Unified Portal Software Solution

05/06 Portal and Collaboration Accomplishments

- GoC Release (Dec 05)
 - Validation of Oracle Software license against RFP requirements
 - GoC Acceptance Received in March 05
- Release 1.020B (Mar. 31/06)
 - Collaboration Pilot (30 users, limited functionality)
 - 20 Portal Licenses Procurement
 - Basic Infrastructure to support pilot
 - In House Training







Unified Portal Software Solution

06/07 Portal and Collaboration Plans

Portal

- Port My Account release 1B into a Portal environment by Dec 2006
- Alignment with Enterprise Secure Access Services (AAFC) to develop a common security model to support access to external users by March 2007
- Alignment with CMS to host AAFC Online in a Portal environment to support My Account by March 2007

AgriForum - Collaboration

- Migration of Orchestra collaboration users to AgriForum
 - Internal users by December 2006
 - External users by March 2007
- Extension of AAFC user base to various business and technical areas interested in using AgriForum to support their following collaboration needs by end of October 2006
 - E.g. AAFC Employees (including teleworkers), other Canadian Departments and Agencies; Provinces and regional offices, etc.







Autonomy's Verity K2 Search

05/06 Accomplishments

- Verity K2 infrastructure on Linux platform
- Replacement of Altavista Search on both internet and intranet sites with Verity K2 full text search
- Advanced search using metadata (date and format) on both internet and intranet sites





Autonomy's Verity K2 Search


06/07 Plans

- Upgrade Verity 5.5 to version 6.1.1
- Implement ODBC Gateway module to allow searching in other databases (e.g. metadata repository and RDIMS)
- Continue developing advanced search functionalities
- Implement Metadata Search pilot
