## APPENDIX- PART 2 – MEMBERS' ALLOWANCES

<p><b>Constituency Allowance</b> - All members are entitled to reimbursement for authorized expenses for the purpose of providing non-partisan access and service to constituents. Maximum annual amounts are set by region for Winnipeg, Southern and Northern Members. Authorized expenses fall under the four categories of Office Space, Office Operation, Staff Salaries and Representation. Equipment and furnishing items costing \$161 and over are property of the Legislative Assembly. Information on each member's maximum annual amount and authorized constituency expenses can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p>Winnipeg Region - \$51,802.00 Southern Region - \$48,036.00 Northern Region - \$46,244.00 Representation expenses are subject to an annual maximum limit of 15% of the Member's Constituency Allowance entitlement.</p>
<p><b>Travel Allowance</b> - All members are entitled to reimbursement for authorized travel expenses. The total amount of expenses eligible for reimbursement varies depending on the size and location of a constituency. The maximum amount of travel expenses eligible for reimbursement for Winnipeg members is \$4,091.00 per member. Information on Southern and Northern member's maximum annual amounts and members' authorized travel expenses can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p>Subject to the specific provisions set out in the Regulation. Out-of-province travel expenses are subject to annual maximum limit of \$3,203.00 within the Member's Travel Allowance amount.</p>
<p><b>Commuter Allowance</b> - Members representing constituencies outside Winnipeg and not entitled to or not claiming reimbursement for authorized temporary residence and living expenses may claim commuting and contingency stay expenses. Information on eligibility for and the amount of reimbursement for authorized expenses can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p><b>Commuting Trips</b> Up to 6 round trips per week when the Assembly is sitting. Up to 2 round trips per week when the Assembly is not sitting. <b>Contingency Stay Expenses</b> Up to 20 overnight stays per sessional period</p>
<p><b>Living Allowance</b> - Members representing constituencies outside Winnipeg, who maintain a residence in both Winnipeg and their constituency, and whose residences in their constituencies are further than 50 kilometres from the Legislative Building are entitled to reimbursement for authorized temporary residence and living expenses. Information on eligibility for and the amount of reimbursement for authorized expenses can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p><b>Temporary Residence Expenses</b> Up to \$1,078.00 per month for rent and utilities. <b>Living Expenses</b> Up to \$648.00 per month when the Assembly is sitting plus 2 additional months, plus any month in which special or standing committees meet. Otherwise \$136.00 a month</p>
<p><b>Alternative Living Allowance</b> - Members eligible for but not claiming temporary residence and living expenses in any month are entitled to reimbursement for authorized overnight stay expenses. Information on eligibility for and the amount of reimbursement for authorized expenses can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p>Up to 8 overnight stays per month.</p>
<p><b>Intersessional Committee Allowance</b> - A Member who is a member of a Standing or Special Committee is entitled to reimbursement for authorized expenses incurred to attend an intersessional committee meeting. Information on eligibility for and the amount of reimbursement for authorized expenses can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p>Actual expenses as approved by the Speaker.</p>
<p><b>Telephone Privileges</b> - Members are issued telephone credit cards for long-distance calls made in carrying out their responsibilities as a Member. Out-of-province charges are to be approved by the Member's caucus Chairperson. Information on eligibility can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Officer or for Members of Executive Council, from their individual offices.</p>	<p>As set out in the Act.</p>
<p><b>Printing and Mailing Privileges (Franking)</b> - Information on constituency householder printing and mailing entitlements can be obtained from the Members' Allowances Office.</p>	<p>As set out in the Act.</p>

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
