

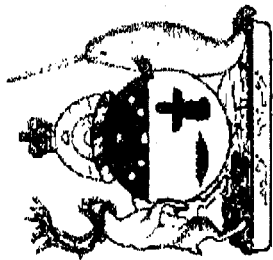

Schedule A - Member Salary and Pay Indemnities

MLA INDEMNITY: This figure is the actual gross annual indemnity based on section 25 of the "LA&EC Act". For income tax reporting purposes the first \$1,000 is tax free pursuant to federal legislation contained in the "Nunavut Act", Part 1, Section 22.

EXTRA DUTIES: Deputy Chair, Committee of the Whole; Chairperson of Standing or Special Committee; Chairperson of Regular Caucus and Chairperson of Full Caucus. Amounts are based upon rates from section 26 and 27 and Schedule C of the LA&EC Act.

OTHER PAYMENTS: By virtue of section 35 of the LA&EC Act, where the rates of pay of employees of the Public Services Act are globally increased by a certain percentage, the MSB may, by regulation, amend Schedule C by the same percentage. This column includes all retro payments and minor pay adjustments.

NORTHERN ALLOWANCE: Northern Allowance rates for MLAs are at the same rates as GN employees. A lump sum saving option allows MLAs to bank Northern Allowance to be paid out the following March. MLAs may select this option, thus the varied allowances paid. Payments made from the banked allowances appear in this report in the year paid.

Schedule B - Travel and Living Allowances

Allowances are provided to assist Members in carrying out their duties. They cover the cost of accommodation, meals, taxis and incidentals for Members attending Sessions and Standing Committee meetings as well as the cost of allowances for travel for constituency business. Living allowances are not considered part of income. Amounts are net GST.

Allowances are set at the GN per diem if the Assembly pays for the Member's lodging and \$250 per day if the Member arranges their own lodging. The column "Other Business" includes allowances paid to the Speaker for representing the Legislature on official functions and the Speaker and other Members attending special functions such as Commonwealth Parliamentary Association events and regional meetings with other Canadian Legislatures. Amounts are net GST.

Schedule C - Constituency Office and Operating Expenses

Constituency operation expenses represent funds reimbursed to Members or paid on their behalf for constituency expenses incurred upon submission of original invoices. Constituency expenses are paid to the maximums per constituency as stated in Schedule B of the LA&EC Act. Expenses are net GST.

Members who exceed their constituency operating budget are required to reimburse the consolidated revenue fund through payment or a reduction in a subsequent allowance. Examples of constituency operating expenses include travel and airline costs, telephone, fax and internet, office supplies, newspaper advertising and promotional materials.

Constituency Base Funding includes expenses paid by the Clerk's Office for the set up and maintenance of Member offices. This includes rent, furniture and staff in their communities.

Other. One time payment to former MLA - 1st Assembly - Kelvin Ng as per MSB Transition Counselling and Training Assistance Policy: \$550.

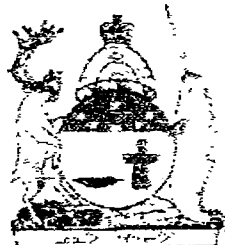
(1) MLA ANNUAL INDEMNITY: This figure is the actual gross annual indemnity based on section 25 of the LA&EC Act. For income tax reporting purposes the first \$1,000 is tax free pursuant to Federal legislation contained in the "Northern Act", Part 1, Section 22. MLA annual indemnities are reported here based on the reporting of 25 complete pay periods and are not adjusted for minor differences caused by fiscal year accounting.

(2) SPECIAL ANNUAL INDEMNITIES FOR EXTRA DUTIES: Deputy Chair, Committee of the Whole; \$3,618; Chairperson of Standing or Special Committee; \$3,269; Chairperson of Regular or Full Caucus; \$2,228. Amounts are based upon rates from April 1, 2004 to March 31, 2005.

(3) OTHER PAYMENTS: This column includes all retro payments and minor pay adjustments by the same percentage. These amounts include all retro payments and minor pay adjustments.

(4) NORTHERN ALLOWANCE: Northern Allowance rates for MLAs are at the same rates as GN employees. A lump sum saving option allows MLAs to bank Northern Allowances to be paid out the following March. Some MLAs opted for this option, thus the lower advances paid. Payment's made from the banked allowances appear in this report in the year paid.

NOTE: Changes in the GN pay system were introduced in December 2004 to implement a 2 week deferred pay cycle. MLAs as well as GN employees were advanced 1 pay in December to be recovered from their final pay upon eventually leaving office. This advance is not included in this report.

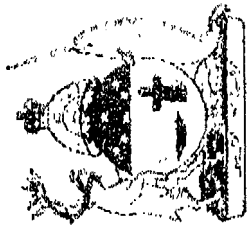

Amounts are net GST.

The above table of expenses relate to the time period April 1, 2004 to March 31, 2005. Constituency expenses represent funds reimbursed to Members or paid on their behalf for constituency expenses incurred upon submission of original invoices. Operating expenses are to a maximum as stated in Schedule B of the Act. Examples of such costs include supplies, advertising, telephone, fax and email costs, and travel for constituency business. Constituency office rents are paid by the Clerk's Office based upon contracts for Member offices in their communities. Constituency Assistant expenses are paid by the Clerk's Office on behalf of the Members to maximums as approved by the MSB (Management & Services Board) and do not include employer premiums. Furniture purchases include desks, chairs, filing cabinets, fax machines, computer equipment and phone technology used in the constituency office. Amounts are net GST.
