Further to your correspondence of May 16, 2006, please be advised that AT&T Global Services Canada Co. ("AGSC") is not a Canadian carrier, and therefore AGSC does not own or operate transmission facilities.

AGSC leases IXPL services (DS-0's, DS-1's, DS-3's and OC-N) from Canadian carriers and uses such facilities to provide services to its end-customers. Where tariffed routes are involved, AGSC leases such facilities from the serving ILEC and pays tariffed rates or leases the facilities. Where forborne routes are involved, AGSC negotiates a price from a Canadian carrier just like any other end-customer.

Based on the foregoing, AGSC does not meet the requirements set out in Order 99-434 for the reporting of IXPL routes. Please remove AGSC from your list for reporting entities in connection with these reports.
