Data-sharing Agreements

To reduce response burden and to ensure more uniform statistics, Statistics Canada has entered into a data maring agreement under section 12 of the Statistics Act with the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC), for the sharing of information from all respondent. Subsection 12(2) of the Statistics Act provides that where a respondent gives notice in writing to the Chief Statistician that the respondent objects to the sharing of the information by Statistic Canada, the information will not be shared with the department of corporation unless the department or corporation is authorized by law to require the respondent to provide the information. The CRTC is authorized by law to require the respondent to provide the information under section 37 of the Telecommunications Act. Information provided to the CRTC will be treated in accordance with the requirements of section 39 of the Telecommunications Act.
