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This survey is conducted by the Public Institutions Division. It is designed to collect financial information in a form permitting the estimation of financial statistics for all local governments well in advance of final statistical reports.

To avoid duplication of enquiry, additional data on current revenue and expenditure will be provided by the British Columbia Ministry of Municipal Affairs using the Financial Reporting Forms (FRF). This questionnaire requests detailed information which is not available in the FRF.

Data collected in this survey along with data from the FRF assist analysts interested in assessing the financial activities of government within the province of British Columbia. The aggregated survey results provide input for the Fiscal Arrangements submission made to the Minister of Finance, the submission to the Income and Expenditure Accounts Division for incorporation into National Accounts statistics, the Financial Management System series of local government revenue and expenditure statistics and submissions to other Divisions in Statistics Canada.

The collection of this information is authorized by the Statistics Act, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, Chapter S19.

Information provided by this survey is covered by the confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act; no data for any individual respondent will be published or transmitted beyond Statistics Canada without the prior approval of the respondent.

The data sought comprise preliminary information for 1999 rounded to the nearest thousand.

Estimation techniques require the use of data for every local government surveyed. Where preliminary data for 1999 are not available please provide your own best estimates.

The concepts and classifications used in this survey are described in the Statistics Canada publication 'A Financial Information System for Municipalities' Volume II (Cat. 12-533).
