I am of the opinion, based on reasonable and probable grounds that a health hazard related to lack of potable water exists at Mississauga Lighthouse Restaurant and the requirement specified in this order are necessary to eliminate the health hazard.

As a result of bacteriological water samples taken on July 5, 2006 the following violation of the Food Premises Regulation 562 was noted;

- 1. Section 20 (1). Every food premise should be provided with,
  - a) a supply of potable water adequate for the operation of the premises.

The reason for the order is that potable water is necessary to maintain disease-free food preparation, proper personal hygiene and sanitation of the premises.

You are hereby advised that this condition constitutes a "health hazard" within the meaning of the Health Protection and Promotion Act, revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990, Chapter H.7.

"Health hazard" means, (a) a condition of a premises

(b) a substance, thing, plant or animal other than man, or

(c) a solid, liquid, gas or combination of any of them, that has or that is likely to have an adverse effect on the health of any person;

## ORDER

Therefore, pursuant to Section 13 of the Act, you are ordered to comply with the following requirements:

- 1. You are directed to immediately close the premise and remain closed until further notice.
- 2. You are directed to procure the professional services of a company engaged in water purification and filtration.

- 3. You are directed to supply Sudbury & District Health Unit evidence of two clear bacteriological water samples taken 24 hours apart, submitted to an accredited Ministry of the Environment laboratory, from the remediated water supply.
- 4. You are directed to immediately place a boil water advisory into effect for the Mississauga Lighthouse Campgrounds.

Failure to comply with this Order is an offence to which you may be liable on conviction to a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for every day or part of each day on which the offence occurs or continues. Failure to comply with this Order may also result in charges under the Criminal Code.

You are advised that, pursuant to Section 44 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act, you are entitled to a hearing before the "Health Services Appeal and Review Board", should you wish to dispute this Notice.

A request for a hearing must be served upon the Medical Officer of Health and to the Appeal Board within 15 days after receiving this Notice. This Notice shall be in effect from the time of service unless, after a notice is filed with the Board, a stay is granted.
