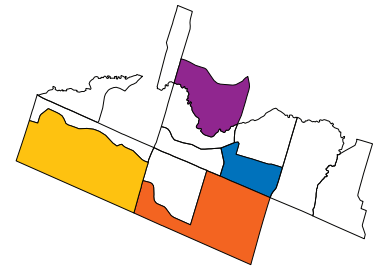


What's New with Sustainable Community Planning and Development?
