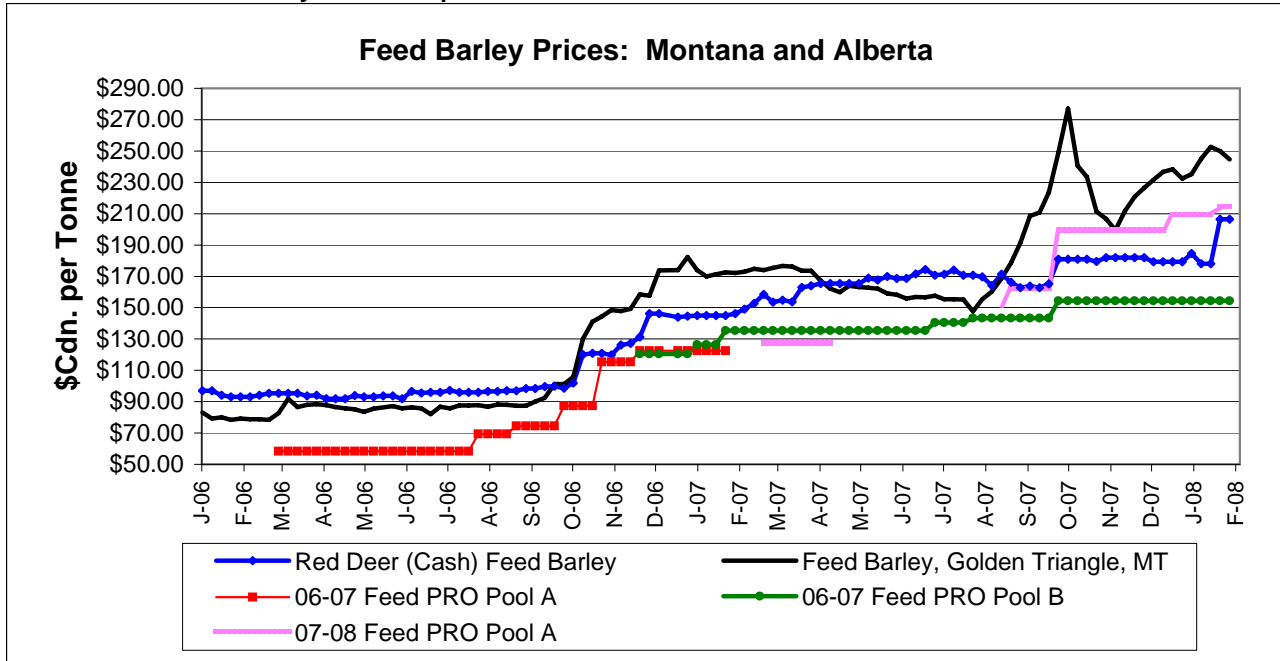


Malt Barley and Feed Barley Prices: Golden Triangle Region, MT and Alberta

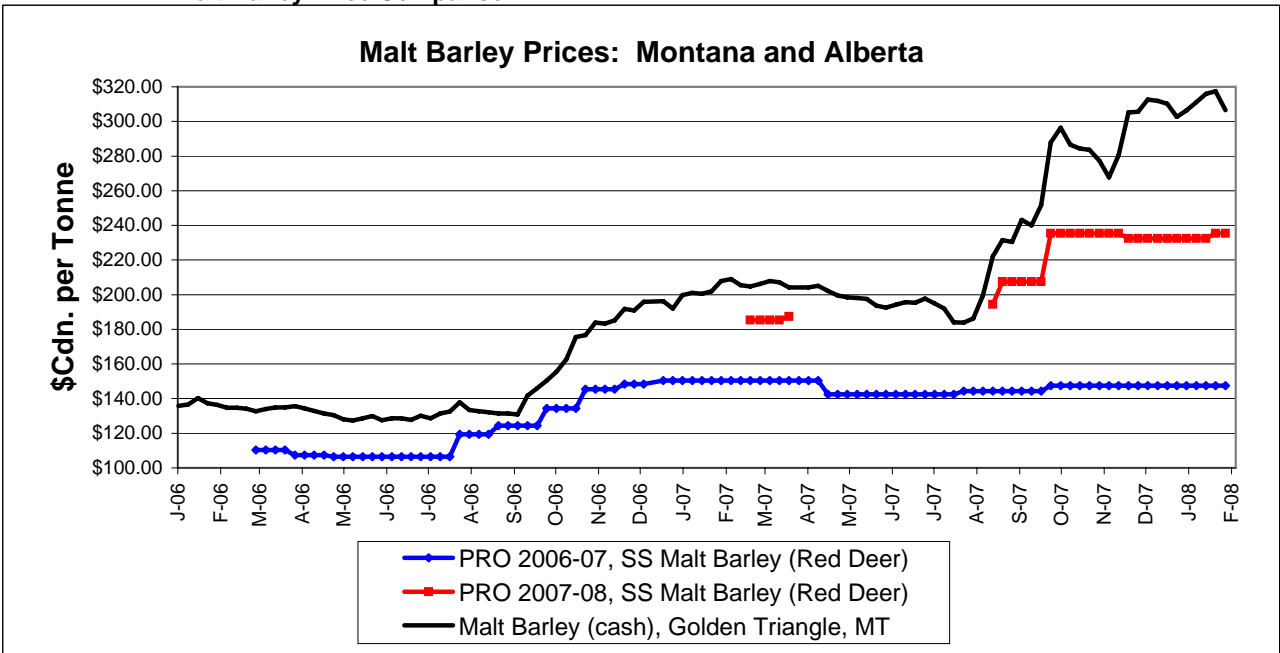

Feed Barley Price Comparison



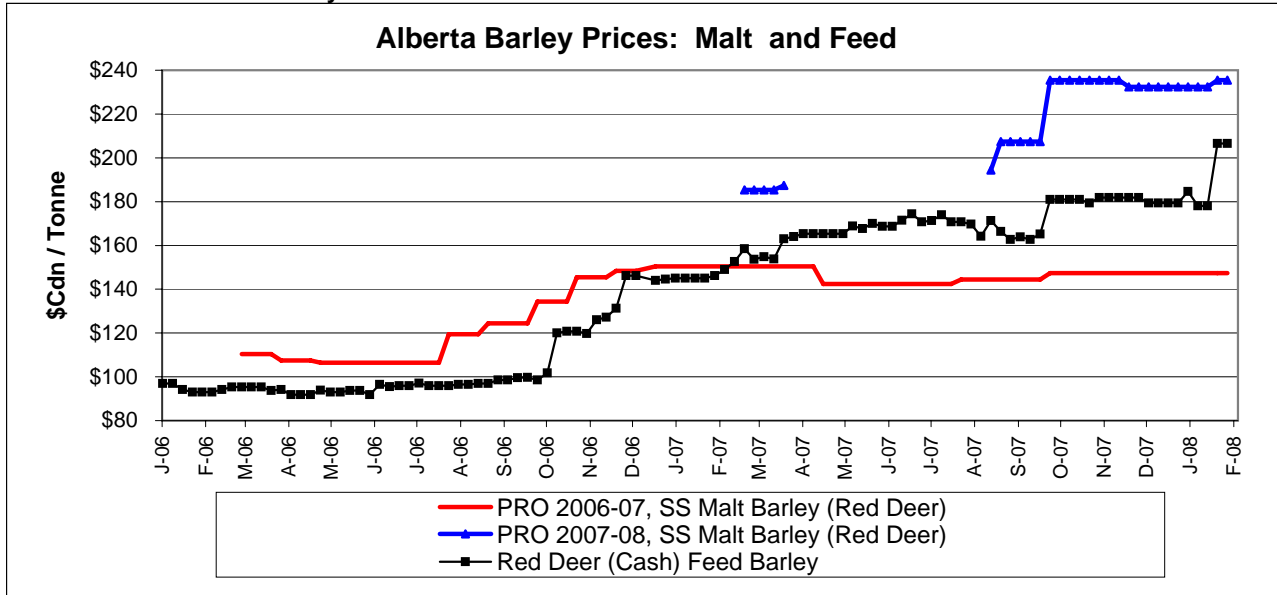
Malt Barley Price Comparison



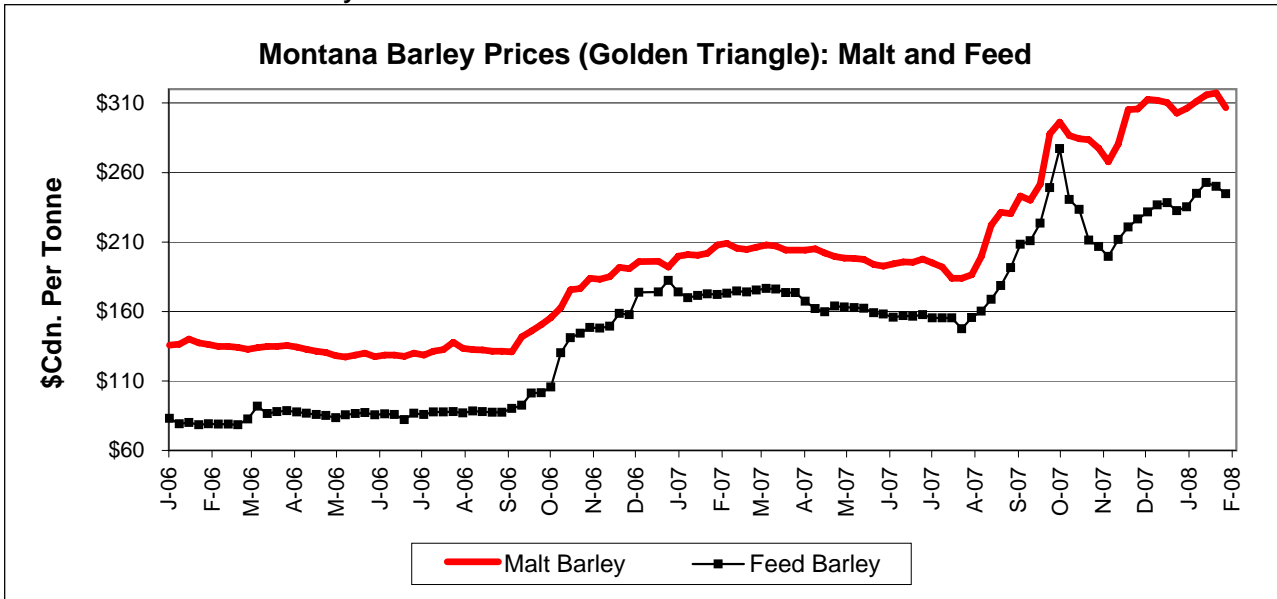

Location:

The specified locations are reasonable for comparison with similar access to malt plants and freight to port costs, which are the main drivers for malt barley prices. Most malt barley in Alberta is grown in the black soil zones such as the Red Deer region. This region is also the main feed surplus area for the province, and thus farm decisions (e.g. growing malt or feed barley, are most significant in this area. [black soil zones](#)
