This initiative is a series of programs designed to build capacity in research and development innovation by supporting the transformation of ideas into products. The fund is structured to promote research, business and commercial collaborations that complement a growing PEI knowledge-based economy and result in the development of commercially viable, technically innovative, and exportable products and services.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligible applicants will be those seeking to commercialize an innovative product, service, technology or process. In general, applications will be accepted from individuals and organizations within an academic, research or private business setting, however eligibility criteria differs for each individual fund.

All disciplines will be considered. Preference will be given to those applications that have a good potential for long-term growth and that encourage partnerships between academic or research organizations and the private-sector.

Application Process

Preliminary proposals must be submitted in accordance with the application procedures as defined in the Research and Development Initiative Program Program Overview at www.techpei.com (Research and Development Section).

The deadline for submission of preliminary proposals is January 15, 2007.
