

Dear Madame Speaker:

We have the honour of submitting the Report of the Chief Electoral Officer pursuant to Section 119 of the *Election Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-1.1 on the provincial general election held on Monday, 28 May 2007.

The 27 Writs of Election were issued on Monday, 30 April 2007 with Ordinary Polling Day set for Monday, 28 May 2007 assigning our retuning officers across P.E.I. to hold an election in each of their districts.

We have the following recommendations that we are asking the Legislative Assembly to consider:

- 1. In response to electors' concerns pertaining to the nomination of election workers at the Advance Polls and on Ordinary Poll (Election Day), Elections P.E.I. is recommending that the registered party which in the general election immediately preceding elected the largest number of members to the Legislative Assembly nominate the Deputy Returning Officers and that the registered party which in the general election immediately preceding elected the second largest number of members to the Legislative Assembly nominate the Poll Clerks. (refer to *Election Act*, section 49 (1))
- 2. Due to the large numbers of electors voting at the Saturday Advance Polls we are recommending that at the first Advance Poll Day, Saturday the ninth day before Ordinary Polling Day, an additional team (consisting of Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks) be incorporated to more efficiently process the increased number of electors. This could be achieved by having one team accept electors in alphabetical order from (A to M) and the second team accepting electors from (N to Z). (refer to *Election Act*, section 82. (4)).
- 3. That the additional four half days of advance polls in the office of the Returning Officer (*Election Act*, section 82. (6)) of each electoral district between the hours of 12 noon and 6:00 p.m. from Wednesday the fifth day before polling day to the Saturday the second day before polling day be rescinded and replaced by adding one additional full Advance Poll day on Friday, the third day before polling day and this Advance Poll Day be carried out under the same voting procedures as the earlier two Advance Poll days (Saturday, the 9<sup>th</sup> day and Monday, the 7<sup>th</sup> day before Ordinary Polling Day).

- 4. Electors have expressed many concerns in respect to familiarizing themselves with new electoral boundaries and in response to this, as well as keeping in step with most other Canadian jurisdictions, we recommend that the *Electoral Boundaries Act* be revised to have the electoral boundaries reviewed by an Electoral Boundaries Commission within ninety days following Ordinary Polling Day of the <u>third</u> general election after the Act comes into force. (*Electoral Boundaries Act*, section 8)
- 5. Elections P.E.I. is experiencing difficulties in booking polling station locations that meet our criteria (ie, wheelchair accessible, parking, etc.), both rural and urban, and we are recommending that the Department of Education in consultation with the respective school boards consider setting Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> May 2011 as a Professional Development Day for school staff which would then permit Elections P.E.I. to use these schools as polling stations.
- 6. There are numerous "housekeeping" amendments and corrections (see two examples below) which should be made to the *Election Act*. These amendments will be discussed with the Legislative Counsel and presented to the Legislative Assembly for its review.

Two samples are as follows:

1. (*Election Act*, section 41) states for nominations: states on the nomination paper includes "the name, address or occupation" and should read "name or address." The requirement to provide candidates' <u>occupation</u> was rescinded in 2003.

2. (*Election Act*, section 56 (A), states: "within the polling <u>district</u>" and should read "within the polling <u>division</u>."

Appreciation is expressed to Ken Kenny, Western Region Elections Coordinator; Reinvented Inc. (Peter and Johnny Rukavina), our IT support; Linda Allen and Carol Murphy, our office support during the election, George MacDonald and John Cox our election drivers; Mike Fagan and staff at the Document Publishing Centre as well to our 27 Electoral District Returning Officers and their Election Clerks and the numerous election workers who worked at the Advance Polls and Election Day polls. The election process on Prince Edward Island is well served by these dedicated professionals and we truly appreciate all the cooperation and expertise provided to us at Elections P.E.I.


The **www.ElectionsPEI.ca** website was used throughout the election period to provide information to electors, the general public, and the media.

## Website Traffic

From April 29, 2007 to June 2, 2007 the site was visited by **14,195 unique users** making **24,226 visits**. The average visitors viewed **6 pages** on the site over an average of **3 minutes and 55 seconds**.

46.5% of visitors to the website were returning visitors and 53.5% were new visitors.

Visits graphed over this period look as follows:



## Sources of Traffic

To access the website 43% of visitors searched using Google, 14% typed in the website address directly, 11% linked from the Government of PEI website, and 5% from the CBC.ca website.

For visitors using a search engine to find the site, the most common search word was "elections pei" (31%) followed by "pei election" (14%), "pei election results" (6%) and "election pei" (6%).

96% of visitors to the website came from Canada: of this traffic, 60% were from PEI and Nova Scotia, 9% from Ottawa, 3% from Toronto, 1% from Montreal.

#### Web Browser and Operating System

82.5% of visitors used Internet Explorer, 14.09% used Firefox, and 1.85% used Safari. All other browsers accounted for less than 1% of usage each.

95.3% of visitors were using Windows-based computers, 4.07% were using a Mac and 0.54% were using Linux.

22% of visitors had a screen resolution of 800x600 pixels or less; the remaining visitors had higher screen resolutions, the most common being 1024x768 (49%).

## **Connection Speed**

Of the 11,202 visitors for which a connection speed could be determined, 63% were using cable-modems, 23% were using a T1, 11% were using DSL, and 3% were using dial-up.

## Results.ElectionsPEI.ca

The **Results.ElectionsPEI.ca** website was used on May 28, 2007 beginning at 7:00 p.m. to provide "live" unofficial election results to the public and to the media. To provide quickest throughput, detailed reporting of traffic to this website was not enabled, however summary information is available.

The results website received **203,187 pageviews** between May 28 and June 2, 2007. The majority of this traffic (89%) was on Regular Polling Day, May 28. A total of 1.49 gigabytes of data was served during this period.

61% of the traffic was to the province-wide summary of results, with the balance to the 27 individual district pages with poll-by-poll results.

The "raw data feed" of results was requested 4,440 times, and the RSS feed of results – provided largely as a mechanism to allow for automated monitoring of results – was accessed 6,352 times.
