Re: Initiation of Bankruptcy Files

In the past, court files in bankruptcy matters were opened by filing one of a variety of documents depending upon the specific relief sought.

Effective July 1, 2007 applicants wishing to open any bankruptcy file must file a requisition in Form 2 accompanied by the supporting document.

The requisition must state the name of the bankrupt, the title of the supporting document, the authority that allows the filing of that particular document and must provide an address for delivery of the applicant.
