## NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION

## RE: REGISTRARS' HEARINGS BY TELEPHONE OR VIDEO-CONFERENCE

A registrar's hearing may now be conducted by telephone or video-conferencing from various registries. The purpose of this procedure is to provide access to a registrar for those registries without a resident Master or where there are no scheduled sittings for a Master or legally trained registrar.

When taking out an appointment for these hearings, a party must also file a requisition in the form attached, requesting that the court file be delivered to the presiding registrar in advance of the hearing date. The requisition should be filed at least 7 days in advance of the hearing date and note any urgency in the delivery of the file.

If the court file is not delivered, the presiding registrar may decline to proceed with the appointment.
