# **Bulk Vendor Application Process and Eligibility Tool Information**

We are pleased to be able to provide you with additional information on the process for issuing the point of sale rebate to customers and submitting your reimbursement application for Your Energy Rebate Program.

### **Customer Eligibility Verification:**

As part of the program, vendors will be required to provide an at-source 8% provincial tax rebate for all eligible customers. Customers of Your Energy Rebate Program generally fall into one of three categories:

- Customers who are eligible for the energy rebate at source
- Customers who are eligible for the rebate via the submission of a paper application and
- Customers who are not eligible for the rebate.

Your role as a vendor in the Program is focused on providing rebates to those customers that are eligible at source for the rebate (i.e. customers identified in the first bullet above).

To ensure a customer is eligible, vendors will be required to confirm their eligibility. There are two ways Service Nova Scotia and Municipal Relations (SNSMR) is helping you to determine customer eligibility.

1. We will provide you with access to an Internet based eligibility system. The system can be used to verify customer eligibility. To access the tool, you can visit <u>www.yourenergyrebate.ns.ca</u>, click on 'Bulk Vendors' and then click on 'Eligibility System'. You will then be prompted to enter the username and password provided below.

2. Customer eligibility can also be determined by calling the Your Energy Rebate bulk vendor line, during regular business hours at 1-888-928-8080 (Monday to Friday 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.).

#### Customer Rebate:

Once you have determined that a customer is eligible to receive the at-source rebate, you will be required to provide them with a receipt displaying the rebate on a separate line item. The receipt must read "Prov Rebate" and must also clearly indicate the rebate percentage, if applicable, and the dollar amount.

#### Reimbursement:

Once customer eligibility has been determined and the rebate provided at the point of sale, vendors will be required to track the rebates issued and will be able to make a submission for reimbursement up to 4 times per month. The key information that you need to collect for the submission period is the amount of energy sold by type of energy source, the total sum of rebates provided and the number of residential customers' transactions where the rebate was provided.

A paper copy of the application can be obtained at any one of the Access Nova Scotia offices throughout the Province or by requesting a copy be mailed to you through the bulk vendor line 1-888-928-8080. Alternatively, you will be able to obtain the application form online at <u>www.yourenergyrebate.ns.ca</u>.
