#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXPORT APPLICATIONS:

Provide a **detailed description** (see page 3) of the wildlife you intend to export. **Supporting documentation** must show wildlife was legally acquired (i.e., Hunter #, Species Licence #, Non-Resident Hunting Licence #, Compulsory Inspection #, Fur Trader Licence, Trapline #, Status #, etc.). Multiple specimens may be included on one permit application; however, **all of the wildlife, wildlife parts, antlers and horns listed on the export permit must be exported in the same shipment, at the same time.** 

When the **hunter** has lost his hunting documentation, a General Permit Application requesting a 2(y) permit must be completed including the following information:

- > Name, address and birth date of applicant.
- > Must state on the application that the applicant hunted the wildlife himself and has lost the documentation.
- > The approximate year that the wildlife was hunted or trapped.
- > The region in which the wildlife was hunted or trapped.
- > A detailed description of the wildlife or parts of wildlife (see page 3 of application).

For wildlife/parts of wildlife that has been purchased at garage sales, estate sales, gifts, etc., applicant must swear a Statutory Declaration and attach a photocopy to the export application The Statutory Declaration should include the following:

- > Name, address and birth date of applicant.
- > A description of how the applicant came into possession of the dead wildlife or parts of wildlife.
- The name of the person, who lawfully hunted, trapped, killed or owned the dead wildlife or parts of wildlife if the applicant is not the original owner.
- > The approximate year that the wildlife was hunted or trapped.
- > The region is which the wildlife was hunted or trapped.
- > A detailed description of the wildlife or parts of wildlife (see page 3 of application)

An export permit is not required if the wildlife being exported within one year of the date of kill provided the hunter accompanies their animal AND provides either the cancelled species licence or where Compulsory Inspection is required, the CI data sheet (which serves as an export permit). \* This does not include wildlife listed under CITES.

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### A DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF WILDLIFE PARTS

A description *must* be provided with an application to export dead wildlife, wildlife parts, horns and mounts. <u>Required</u> details are as follows:

#### Antlers:

- Type of wildlife
- Indicate whether antlers are sets or singles
- Indicate whether skull plate is attached
- Indicate whether there is a complete skull or partial skull
- Indicate whether antlers, skull plate or complete skull are artificial
- Indicate if the antlers are cast (shed)

#### Horns:

- Type of wildlife
- Sheep and Mountain goat information can be taken directly from the Compulsory Inspection sheet

#### Mounts:

- Type of wildlife
- Type of mount (ie. life-size mount, head mount, etc.)
- If antlered, please follow antler requirements (above)

#### Capes, Hides or Rugs:

- Type of wildlife
- Life-size or partial
- Head, paws and claws attached
- Raw, salted, dried, or tanned

#### Meat:

- Type of wildlife
- Approximate # of pounds

#### Feathers:

- Type of wildlife
- How many feathers

Migratory insectivorous birds or migratory non-game birds can not be exported
