

In-house Lobbyist (Company) Registration Form

Complete this form if, under the *Lobbyists' Registration Act*, you are an employee who, as a significant part of your duties, lobbies the provincial government on behalf of your employer. In-house lobbyists (company) include employees of persons, companies and partnerships that carry on commercial activities for financial gain. See the Guide to the Registry of Lobbyists for greater detail on the types of lobbyists and when they are required to register. A return is to be filed with the Registrar within two months after the day on which the individual becomes an in-house lobbyist, and within 30 days of each six-month anniversary of the initial filing.
