Lillooet Area Library Association's Book Bus Set to Roll this Month

BCTC provides \$6,000 to support travelling library program

VANCOUVER/LILLOOET, BC – BC Transmission Corporation (BCTC) has donated \$6,000 to the Lillooet Area Library Association's Book Bus program to help refurbish a second hand bus to serve as a "library-on-wheels". The bus is now ready to visit Lillooet communities this month in a series of "Open Bus Days."
