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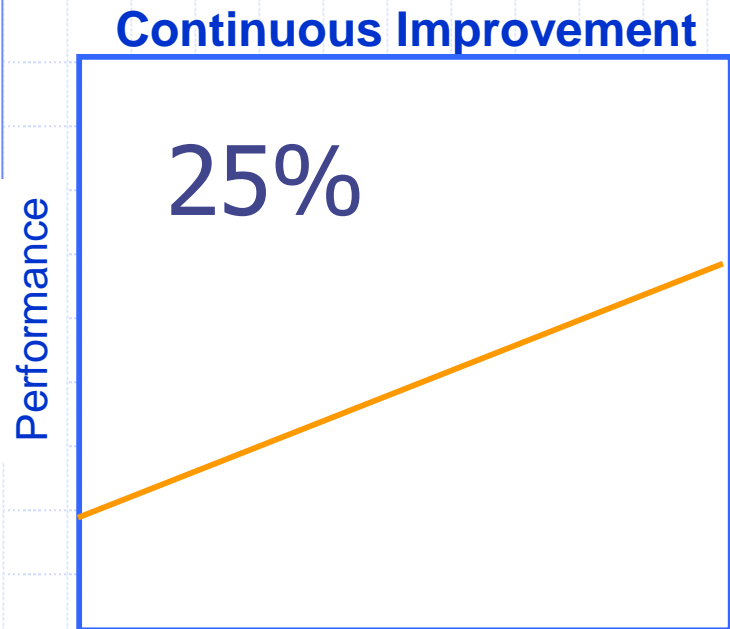

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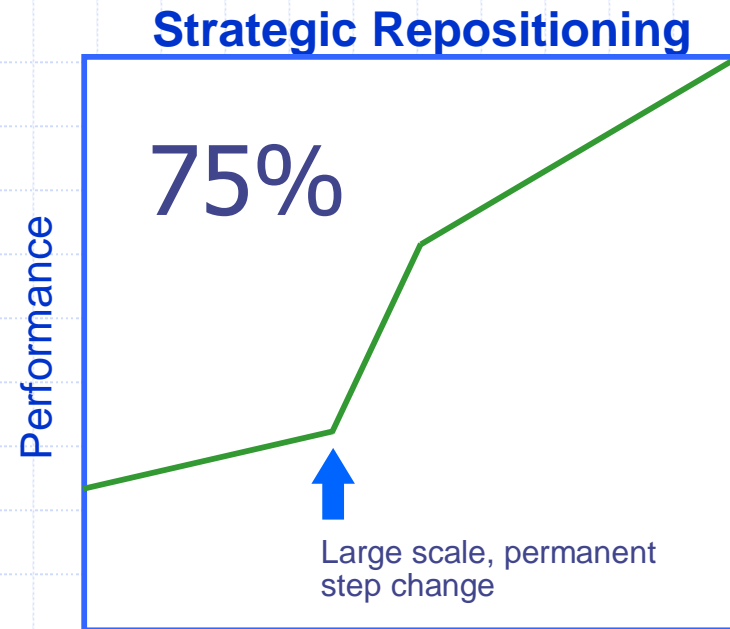


# Pace of Implementation:

Integrated, sustained effort by a cross industry team of individuals

# Legislative Process

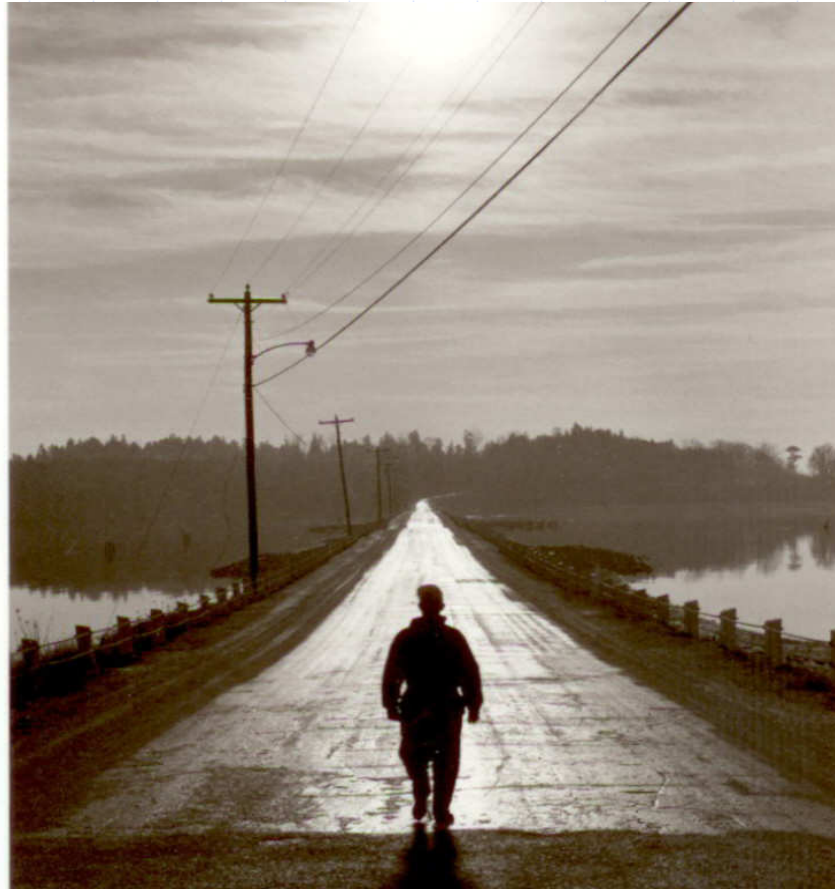
- ◆ Spring 2008
