### New Revised Statutes of Alberta

Official consolidation now in force - January 1, 2002

The Revised Statutes of Alberta (RSA) 2000 is the official consolidation of our provincial statutes, authorized by the Statute Revision Act enacted in 2000.

RSA 2000 follows the procedures of prior revisions in 1980, 1970, 1955, 1942 and 1922. Not only does it officially consolidate the laws, but it renumbers most Acts, uses gender-neutral terminology wherever possible, and corrects outdated references. The intent of the law remains unchanged.

When the new revision was proclaimed in force (January 1, 2002), it repealed and superseded public Acts in force as of December 31, 2000, except as indicated in the schedules. The supplement includes the schedules and a table of concordance relating the provisions of each Act as they existed on December 31, 2000 to the corresponding provisions in RSA 2000.

Subsisting public Acts contained in RSA 1980 or enacted between January 1, 1981 and December 31, 2000 have been consolidated into a 13-volume set. Both hardbound and loose-leaf versions are available from Alberta Queen's Printer. The electronic version of the Revised Statutes is published in Microsoft Word.

A notable new feature of the Statute Revision Act is to permit the revision of only specific legislation in the future, in addition to full revisions such as RSA 2000. Thus, over time, we may see revisions of only Acts which have received substantial amendments.
